Hello! This is Dorothy -

I do trust that today you feel confident that you are a child of God. I do not care what label you have of your religion or what background you have, but it is tremendously important to see that when Jesus died on the Cross, He knew about you. He went to the Cross and He loves you! Not only did He die for you, He died that the price of your sin could be paid for; that He might make you a new person; that He might, by His Holy Spirit, come to live in you. But that is not all : that you might have eternal life. Eternal life goes on and on and on.

“But,” you say, “what about when I die? I am so frightened of dying. What about this place of having to work my way to heaven and accomplish many things?” Do you realize that no man can make it to heaven? No person on the face of this earth is holy enough to make it to heaven! Even one thought would keep you out of heaven. Therefore, it was necessary for God, who is holy and the Creator of the heavens and the earth, to come and take upon Himself a body, a spotless body. That is why He had this amazing birth. This birth did not have contaminated blood, but He was born in this body and was a perfect, spotless human being, that He, in that flesh, might take that flesh to the Cross, and die for you. Why am I emphasizing this?

Because so many can be delivered and not realize the work has been done, but you must personally turn to the Lord Jesus Christ. I want you to realize that He died in your place to pay a debt He did not owe (and that was for sin), because we owed a debt (that is our sin) that we could not pay. All the attempts in this world cannot pay the price, but Jesus paid it. Therefore, it's saying, *Thank You* to the Lord. Could you imagine being in a desert place and you were desperate for a drink of water and somebody brought you a drink of water? Would you just say "Thank you," especially if it was the water that they could have drunk, that they had the right to have, but they gave totally everything they had for you?

In **John 5:24**, we read **Verily, verily** - and whenever there is an emphasis twice or three times, God is getting our attention. This is really *surely, surely* - **I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life . . .** You can have everlasting life now if you do what it says - if you, as you are hearing His Word, believe on the Lord Jesus Christ. And what's more, you . . . **shall not come into condemnation.** That is so amazing to me — that before a holy God, the spotless Son of God, Jesus, will say, "My child. Receive this dear one, because this is my child, because she put her trust in Me." If you are willing to do this, don't you see He is standing on your behalf and there is no condemnation? There is no condemnation when we come before a holy God, and there is no

condemnation now. People might be putting terrible condemnation on you – perhaps the disease that you have; perhaps the terrible things that have happened; perhaps you have tried to commit suicide; perhaps you have done something awful. I do not know what it is. There is a price for those things we have done in this life, but I can assure you there is no condemnation as far as the Lord is concerned. Therefore, it's so amazing to me, for it says, we have . . . **passed from death unto life. (verse 24).**

In **1 Peter 1:3**, we read He's made us alive **unto a lively hope. . .** And in **John 14:19**, we read . . . **because I live, you shall live, also.** *That is Christ Jesus.* We are alive! We are not just going around with this terrible burden of disease and distress.

In **1 Corinthians 6**, we read

17 But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit.

19 What! Know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy

Spirit which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?

20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

Will you say, Thank You, Lord. I am receiving you right now. My life is the Lord's! He is going to take it and cleanse it and fill it. Thank You, Lord, I am so excited! I am His child with no condemnation for all eternity! Thank You, I love You, Lord Jesus.
