

Glory in Tribulations

Hello! This is Dorothy -

Good Morning! I do trust that you have entered into this day and made yourself available to the living God. Isn't this a wonderful hope that we have in our Lord, to know that we can glory in tribulations? "Oh dear," you say, "I do not know whether I like that kind of a message."

Well, I am reading in **Romans, chapter 5**. We read in **verse 3- . . . we glory in tribulations. . .** When we . . . **rejoice in hope. . .** we can glory in the worst things happening. This is the time to rejoice! "But," you say, "the picture is so black and so bleak!" Yes, but it isn't to the Lord. The Lord is in full control of knowing what is happening. He is King of kings and Lord of lords; He has gotten us the victory through Christ Jesus on the Cross. Therefore, let us stop moaning and despairing, and let's look to the living Christ! Let's at this moment say, *Yes, Lord. I have hope in You in the worst tribulation.*

5 . . . because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Spirit which is given unto us. Do you know anything

about the shedding of the love of God in your heart? Do you know anything about being full of the Holy Spirit? Do you know that the right of every child is to daily walk in the fullness of the Lord?

There is a verse in **Ephesians** which says to go on being filled. It does not mean it will not happen one time. When we come into Christ, we are born of the Spirit and we are commanded of the Lord to go on being filled. So when I blow it and I am all in despair; but at that moment, I can thank God for the victory of Jesus Christ. I can simply ask Him to fill me afresh with His Spirit. *Fill me, Lord, with your Spirit, even now. I want to forsake the things that have bound and held me. I want to confess them and make them right. And I want to be filled full of Your Spirit. For only in You there is hope. There is rejoicing in the worst hour, because the worse mess You are quite able to take care of! You are fully aware of this life which you have purchased with Your Blood. Therefore, Lord, it is to Your glory, as the heavenlies watch on, that You will bring me through in triumph and victory.*
