

*Hello! This is Dorothy -*

I would like to turn in **Leviticus**, which is in the Old Testament, to a very important subject in **chapter 20**. In **verse 2**, we read of people giving of their own seed, that is, their own children to the god Molech. What has all this to do with us today, you might ask? There was modern Molech worship going on right in the hospital in London, where I came in as a patient one night. I found that children of twelve and thirteen were being encouraged to give of their children, as it were, as if they were just some piece of old garbage. But, they did not realize the giving up of these children in this awful thing called abortion, was nothing more than Molech worship. What is this that is taking place about the destroying of babies? It is because, in destroying the baby, what we are doing is giving the baby over to Satan. We are handing lives that were made for God to somebody who hates any life on the face of this earth. . . . **my mother might have been my grave - Jeremiah chapter 20, verse 17**. In other words, any one of us could have died within our mother's womb. But to deliberately kill a baby in a mother's womb is a very serious matter. When we look at verses that show that before we were born, we find the Greek word *brefis*, which means we were breathed upon by God. This is life, which is unto Himself.

In **Psalm 139 verses 13 to 16**, our Lord is speaking and we read we were known in our mother's womb. In other words, this amazing creation of you and me in our mother's womb was chosen by God to bring you into the world, that you might know the Lord and that your life might be His. For us to take another life and to destroy that life in somebody's womb is like going out and taking a gun and shooting the first person we see and killing them Their blood flows out and that is the end of them. I do not think we understand fully that God says Molech worship is demonic. Molech was a statue with arms extended to hold a baby. "Well," you say, " how lovely; how beautiful." Yes, it sounds that way, but those arms were made red hot, and the living baby was put in those burning arms and tortured to death! That was the sacrifice to the god Molech! We are told over and over again that when we sacrifice to any god (small g), we are sacrificing to Satan; we are sacrificing to demons; we are sacrificing to get rid of life, because Satan hates what God has done for you and me. You see, God chose to come into the world as a baby. He could have suddenly appeared with a great host from above and said, "I am God. Worship Me." But He came as a baby. He limited Himself as a baby, spotless, pure, holy, to be dependent upon His mother's breast, to be weaned, and to toddle, and to work in his father's carpentry shop. This father was not his Father; he was a father, who acted as the husband of Mary to raise Him. His Father was His Heavenly Father. For that holy thing that was

born in the virgin Mary was by the Spirit of God, the living God, made flesh that He might come and sacrifice His life on your behalf and mine, that He might die for your sin and mine that we might be saved.

Oh dear, dear lady, if you struggle with this matter, God forgives the sin of yesterday if you confess it. But it is so important to realize that the baby in your womb was created of God for Him. Bring that little child, even at this moment if you are bearing a child, unto Jesus for His life to be manifest through that precious one, and for the glory of God, win others for Himself.
