

*Hello! This is Dorothy -*

I am looking at **Exodus chapter 25**, which speaks of the tabernacle. Our God came down from Heaven to a manger and to a Cross. We may draw near to Him as we meet Him first at the foot of the Cross. Have you ever met Jesus? Have you really come to know Him personally? That is where you meet Him — at the foot of the Cross. You see, it is at the foot of the Cross where the fire of judgment for you and for me fell upon our beloved Lord Jesus. Atonement was actually made and that is why it is the only way we can go with Him to heaven. By the precious Blood, the cleansing, we can come into His holy presence, because we are cleansed by that precious Blood. As a sinner, we must first meet God at the altar of sacrifice. Have you done that? I trust so. I want you to go to heaven. It is not by your works, but by what Jesus has done. Before we may talk to God in prayer and enter into His very throne-room as it were, we have to come by faith because of the shed Blood of His well-beloved Son. Perhaps you are having trouble getting through in prayer and you feel you just cannot talk to God. Perhaps it is that you need Jesus as your personal Saviour.

In the tabernacle, only priests could go into the holy place. Then just

once a year, only the high priest could enter the Holy of Holies. He first made sacrifice for his own sin and then he brought the blood of the sacrifice to represent the people. The tribe of Levi was the actual tribe that was chosen by God on His behalf to come before Him. But notice that he had to return year after year after year, because even the high priest was but a type of our Lord Jesus.

The holy place was separated in the area from the Holy of Holies by a veil. Inside the holy place were three pieces of furniture. Now just imagine this. The furnishings are really like the shape of a cross. There was a square room, which was the Holy of Holies. Twice the length of the room behind was the holy place. In the holy place were three pieces of furniture. One, right behind the veil, was the golden altar of incense. As you enter that room, over to the right was what was called the table of showbread, upon which were twelve loaves of bread, representing the twelve tribes of Israel and also the Bread of Life, Jesus. On the other side, there was light, the only light to this room: a golden menorah of golden candlesticks, speaking of Jesus, the Light of the world. The great high priest came to this place, this golden altar of incense. (Gold speaks of deity.) There, he prayed for the people. That is exactly what Jesus is doing right now. He is our High Priest. He is praying for me. I love this! I never realized this when I was outside of Christ, but since I have come into Christ, I am grateful for everybody who prays for me, but, oh, how grateful I am that He is my

Intercessor and my Priest as He comes before the Father on my behalf.

I want Him to be your Priest and your Intercessor. I want you to have direct access to God; not going through other ways and means to reach Him. That is why the Word of God shows that Jesus is the Way. Jesus is the true Light to make this possible. Jesus is that Bread of Heaven come down. He is the One that as we look into the Holy of Holies, we realize the Shekinah of God. For in **2 Corinthians 4:6**, we read - **For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.** It is all about Jesus! It is all about Him. Natural light was excluded from the tabernacle. Not a man-made thing; just the light of the golden candlestick. The light of the Life of Jesus Christ. You know, we read in **Genesis 1:16- And God made two great lights; the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night . . .**

***The greater light*** is the type of Christ, **the Sun of righteousness.**  
**Malachi 4:2.**

I just praise God that as the table of showbread represents Jesus, As the Nourisher of born again believers, He nourishes you and me. It is not just living bread; it is something that is going to forever and ever feed your soul. It is not something you have today and you are hungry tomorrow. Many of you, no doubt, are hungry at this moment.
