

Hello! This is Dorothy -

What a joy it is as we turn to the Word of God and we see what He has to say to our hearts. There is a verse in **Luke 24:44**, which says -

. . . all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning me. It

is so important to see that all that we are reading in the Old Testament points to the accomplished work of Jesus Christ upon the Cross.

Therefore, that is the focal point. That is what the tabernacle, in **Exodus**, which we started to read over these days, is all about. It shows us that God was showing the way of how to approach Him.

There is a verse I want us to think about. I feel so many of us don't understand satanic warfare. Oh, that is a word we do not like to talk too much about; we like to think Satan will go away if we do not mention his name! But we sense a battle going on around us. In

Hebrews 2, we read —

14 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he - *this is speaking of Jesus* - also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him - *that is Satan* - that had the power of death - *that is the devil* -

15 And deliver them who through fear of death were all their

lifetime subject to bondage.

Have you ever looked into the eyes of somebody and you just feel tremendous bondage in their eyes? Their face might give an expression of delight to meet you; they might even be smiling, but there is something holding, something binding, that life. It could be they do not even have a happy look. Perhaps they represent how you are feeling right now. Perhaps you are very, very aware that there is something going on inside of you and you are just not free. You don't understand it. Perhaps you have dabbled in things that have to do with witchcraft. Perhaps you have been into things you know have to do with evil, that is, outside of the realm the Lord said to have anything to do with. How grateful I am that Jesus conquered Satan! How grateful I am that the Lord has gotten us the victory and we do not have to live in this spirit of fear. We can live in His love and with a sound mind. We can be delivered. Perhaps today you have to stand right now and say, *Jesus, I take that position.*

You know, there is a verse in **1 Timothy 6:12**, which says **Fight the good fight of faith . . .** - That is not speaking about the works of man, but it is standing in the position of faith. Perhaps for yourself, you have to say, *O Father in Heaven, I come in the Name of Jesus and I renounce any allegiance given to Satan. I would be free of this bondage. I*

would be free of that which has been holding me. I have sensed the oppression and the evil and all but the laughing and jeering of the enemy against me. Oh, that I would be free! I want to be totally free in You, Christ Jesus, and I thank You that You paid the price to make this possible. Therefore, as you pray that in the Name of Jesus, understand that when the Lord said, **Fight the good fight of faith**, enter into what He has. It goes on to say - . . . **lay hold on eternal life** . . . That is what it is all about. When you come to Christ, there is a life that has begun which doesn't just finish when your body goes into some kind of a coffin: it is an eternal life! It is a process which will go on forever and forever. You are very alive, even if your body is giving out right now through some horrible disease or some situation that is crippling you. Listen, dear, dear beloved one in Christ, you have eternal life. **Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold of eternal life** . . . For it goes on to say . . . **whereunto thou art also called** . . . *-this is Paul speaking to his protegee, his kind of child in the faith, as it were, Timothy . . .* **and hath professed a good profession before many witnesses**. In other words, do not just give up! Don't just look back at yesterday; look to tomorrow. See what Christ wants to do through that situation for you. God has a way of putting a light in a very dark place. Would you be available to be that light in that very dark place? Perhaps, having gone through so many terrible situations, and as your heart has been made clean, may it be that you have the discernment to see others in such situations who need to be set free

and prayed for. I do trust so. I do understand that some of you have perhaps never understood that even from generation to generation there have been curses holding and binding. Somehow you feel that you cannot get free from this, because that was in the family and so demonic and terrible. I want you to find others who love Jesus and have them pray with you. Enter into victory and start to praise and adore and worship the Lord, for He set you free. Satan has to go.

You know, Scripture clearly implies that Satan isn't reigning in hell. There are a lot of misinformed stories that have circulated, but, instead, he is the prince of this present world system. The present world system is organized in such a way that he has his forces of evil that often bring about control of the headship of nations to bring about wars and envying and greed and ambition and sinful, evil things. But in Jesus, we can know freedom from the god of this world, because Jesus has paid that price! In Jesus, I am safe; I am secure. Satan has to go, because the Lord is my Defender and I give Him all praise.
