

Hello! This is Dorothy -

It is such a joy to come in the Name of the Lord Jesus and to speak to you. I have nothing to share except what His Word has to say. Yet, together as we listen to His Voice, let Him do that work within us which He intends to do so that He can get all the glory. Please realize that these are not just messages that are being turned out, but they are messages directed by the Spirit of the Lord to you. We are speaking about Almighty God. We are speaking about Him Who is light. We have seen this depicted in the Holy of Holies. You see, there is no artificial light in the Holy of Holies, because there is no need. In **Matthew 17:2**, Jesus was actually transfigured, if you remember, before Peter, James, and John. We read . . . **his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.** This is our God. Over in **Revelation 1:16**, John saw the risen Lord . . . **and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength.** He could not explain it; He could not explain the light; He could not explain this brightness. How can you explain it? What words could you use? And I love it - at the end of **Revelation** in **chapter 21-**

23 **And the city.** . . - *this is speaking about Heaven - this is the place where only those who love and know the Lord Jesus can go -*
. . . had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for

the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb. . . - *the Lamb of God, Jesus - . . . is the light thereof.*

25 . . . for there shall be no night there. My, have you noticed where there is a light, you automatically go there? Can't you see, we will not be looking at one another and saying, "Well, I did better than you down there.?" It is all going to be about the Light, about Jesus. The eternal glory, which Jesus had with the Father before the world was, shines from within His very being. It fills Heaven with its light. By His grace, we shall one day behold and share this glory. And, I love this: . . . **we shall be like him. . . (1 John 3:2.)** What shall we be like? We shall be like Him. There will be the glory; there will be the light; there will be the wonder. He has gone to prepare a place for us and what a glorious place it is going to be! We are going to be there for all eternity.

Oh, some of you are going through such difficult times. Everything is so bleak and so dark. You are depressed; you feel as if you can hardly get through one more day. You wonder where the money is going to come from; you wonder how much more you can put up with predicaments in your particular place where God has put you. Be encouraged! We are here but for a short time. But even while we are here, let us go into the Holy of Holies. Let us look into the Holy of Holies. Let us approach the Holy of Holies like one who would come looking at the sacrificial Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ and, because

of that, enter His presence.

The Bible shows us, over and over, just in talking about the tabernacle, something which we read God built, depicts something of what Heaven is all about. In **Revelation 11:19**, we read - **And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament - the ark of his covenant . . .** In other words, what God gave was a picture when He gave the tabernacle and later the temple. He said, "This is a picture of what Heaven is about."

"Oh," you say, "now I know what Heaven is like. Will I see a building like I read of the tabernacle?" No. Understand everything about the tabernacle is a story about Jesus. It is a way of approach to a Holy God. You know, the tabernacle is far more important than perhaps you realize. Did you know that it actually takes fifty chapters of the Bible? That is how much the Bible speaks of the tabernacle. In the Old Testament, it is thirteen chapters in **Exodus**, which speak about the tabernacle; there are eighteen in **Leviticus**; in the **Book of Numbers**, there are thirteen; and in the **Book of Deuteronomy**, it is mentioned on two occasions. Then when you turn to the New Testament, you read four chapters in the **Book of Hebrews**, which talk about the tabernacle: coming this way to God; understanding what Heaven is about; understanding the principle that we come to a Holy God only through the Lord Jesus Christ. In fact, if you add all those chapters together, it makes fifty. Isn't that impossible to imagine? Fifty chapters

in the Bible are taken up with the tabernacle. It is like taking the whole **Book of Genesis**. There are fifty chapters in the **Book of Genesis** and they are all talking about the tabernacle.

The tabernacle is very important to understand. It is the picture of how you can come to Jesus. You know, we read in **Hebrews 9:22 -And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.** In other words, there is no other way of being accepted.

Come to Jesus today and see it is by His precious Blood. Send for that book, *Your Quest for God*. The Lord will meet you in that holy place.
