We have been talking about the feasts of the Old Testament. I want to talk today about the *Feast of Trumpets*. It starts with a holy day and in the Old Testament we read that trumpets were sounded. This feast will be fulfilled when the 70th year (week) of Israel's history of salvation as a nation begins. There is a section in **Daniel**, which explains that everything took place exactly as

Scripture indicated, except this one section of time, which represents seven years. There will be seven years in which there will be the happenings, which are described in multiple sections of the Bible as the pouring out of God's wrath upon this world. In fact, sections show it will be that nobody would survive were it not for the intervention of God at the end of this time. We are living in a period of time that is called the *Day of Grace*.

In **Jeremiah 8, verse 20**, we read -

20 The harvest is past, the summer is ended, and we are not saved. I do not want it to be that you, as you listen now, are in that place that you are not saved. For the Jews, the Old Testament shows, the seventh month marks virtually the end of the harvest. You see, seven feasts are depicted, especially in **Leviticus 23**. Four of those feasts, we have discussed, but between the fourth feast and the beginning of the fifth feast, there was the longest period of time. In this section of time, it shows the gathering of the harvest. This is the harvest of people like yourself who want to receive and know the Lord Jesus Christ. As you come to know the Lord Jesus Christ, realize you could be the very last person as the harvest is being complete.

When this very critical period of Israel's history dawns, they will, as a nation, still be unsaved. The end of the harvest season will mark the beginning of this Daniel's 70th year - **seventy weeks** as it is

described, a time in which Israel will be tried and persecuted. Jerusalem will be surrounded by the armies of hostile nations. The hour we are living in points to so much. However, although it is a very late hour in the harvest season, a special opportunity will nevertheless be offered to the Jews to be saved.

Hosea 6 says -

11 Also, O Judah, he hath set an harvest for thee, when I returned the captivity of my people.

What is the Old Testament talking about? It is showing history taking place, right underneath our noses! You see, in a sense, God's people, the Jews, all the way through the Old Testament, had everything going for them, but they rejected the Lord. Therefore, God laid them aside. It was as if He put over their eyes cataracts; they could not see; they were blinded to what God was doing. They rejected Messiah at the Cross of Calvary. Therefore, a window of opportunity came, a blessed window for you and me if we are Gentiles, that we can come to know Jesus. But that window also is closing very soon. The harvest is ready; it is about to be complete, and we who love and know Jesus will be taken out of the scene.

Then, according to **Zechariah 12:10**, this week is referring to what is called Jacob's trouble for God is going to come in a very unique way and He is going to reach His people. Sadly, the Scriptures show, there will only be one third of His people that survive in that dreadful onslaught of dreadful happenings to take place yet in the

Middle East. Only one third will turn, but those who do turn are going to see that they are turning to their Messiah that they have looked for for so long. This is all tied up with talking about the harvest, *the feast of trumpets*. This is something that Paul literally is talking about - the feast of prophetic indications of future events to be fulfilled at the time of the coming of the Messiah. All these things have been shown exactly to the most finite detail of being fulfilled.
