

Hello! This is Dorothy —

What a joy to share the Scriptures with you! Oh, may our hearts be open for all that the Lord has to say. May be, in turn, share these marvelous things that the Lord is revealing to us, that He is coming soon, not only with our dear ones, but realizing we need to share an urgency for the lives about us. There is an amazing Scripture, which tells us about how He is going to come. It is called **falling away**. In **2 Thessalonians 2**, we read —

1 **Now we beseech you, brethren . . . that means men, women, boys and girls . . . by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto him.**

2 **That you be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is now present.**

The Apostle Paul was writing to a situation where somebody had deceived the people by writing a letter, which had not really been from him. You see, everybody was anticipating, as the Lord went up as He said, “In like manner, I will come again.” That was His ascension. Therefore, they were anticipating His return. Then somebody wrote this false letter saying, “Oh, you know, that is not going to happen,” so they were deceived.

Paul goes on to say,

3 Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first . . . noticed that phrase . . . and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;

4 Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God . . . we call him the Antichrist . . . or that is worshiped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God.

Well, first of all, what about this **falling away**? In Greek, the word is

apostasias. It is a departure verb. It means *to depart* and it is used in the New Testament fifteen times. Only one does it actually mean *fall away*; fourteen times it means to depart, to leave from. Therefore, it is important to understand that when the Lord speaks through this section in **2 Thessalonians 2**, He is going to cause that we leave from. The Lord will descend and come for the Church in the air. When the Lord Jesus Christ comes, He is not going to put His feet on the ground; He is going to come in the air. This verb will literally mean in another rendering: we are *to be snatched away*. He is just going to come. He will raise the sleeping and change the living saints. To the believer, it radically affects my life today. It radically affects the commission He has put on me today.

I do not serve God from nine to five; twenty-four hours every day of the week, I am available for His life. I have been purchased to be

available for His life. I live anticipating His coming.

Now the rapture will take place immediately before a period of time when is called in Scripture, Jacob's Trouble, the Tribulation. This is a time when the wrath of God is going to be poured upon this world.

It goes on to say - **He who restrainteth**. . . This is speaking of a Person. This could be none other than the Holy Spirit speaking to the Church. We will be taken out of the way. In other words, right now, with all the evil that seems to surround the multiple places in which we are living, there is an evil out there. But do you know you are light in that situation? God the Holy Spirit is living in you.

The Holy Spirit living in you is having an impact in that community in not just what you do, but as the very impact of light in such a dark situation. Do

Do you understand that when we who love the Lord Jesus are snatched away, the Holy Spirit is working in us in multiple lives? Imagine all of that going up! Could you imagine the rampart position of evil in that situation? Therefore, you are light and you are life in a situation because of God the Holy Spirit within you.

Therefore, when that Person, the Holy Spirit, take us out, that day God's wrath will be poured out. In that amazing timing, it fulfilled this feast of trumpets from the Old Testament. It is the gathering

of the harvest. You see, we are part of this incredible harvest going on. But, you know, in the light of what we are reading, a verse comes to me very, very clearly from **2 Coritnhains chapter 5**

—

11 Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men . . . We are His mouthpiece right now. Share the Lord Jesus. Come to Him in such a way that you see you are His vessel.
