

*Hello! This is Dorothy —*

It is a great joy to speak with you today. I do encourage you to run to the Lord; I do encourage you to dwell upon Him. There are so many gimmicks and ideas coming down the pipeline; so many things that overwhelm us as we are trying to meet to some level of conformity; trying to be what I cannot be; trying to somehow get along; trying to psychoanalyze all the things that are going on. But I want to assure you right now that it is terribly important that the Lord Jesus Christ be All in all in the center of your life.

You know, Jesus declared in **John 10:35** -

**35 . . . the scripture cannot be broken.** The word ***broken*** means to repeal, annul or abolish. That means that Scripture cannot be emptied of its force by being shown by some person to be erroneous or some person who decides that we can cut it up a little bit or change what the Word is saying. The Word of God declares the sinlessness of Jesus Christ. We are looking at our beautiful Lord Jesus Christ, absolutely sinless. God requires people to be holy because He is holy. *Sin*, of which we all are aware, can be defined by *any failure to conform perfectly to the holy character and will of God*. Can you see, we need a holy Saviour? It is only in Jesus we can meet that which is of the Word declared a must. It is the

holy God wanting us to meet Him through the Holy Spirit by a holy child called Christ Jesus. You remember that, don't you, in **Luke 1:35** when the angel Gabriel declared that the child to be born of the virgin Mary would be holy?

In **Psalm 16:10**, we read -

**10 For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.** King David foretold that the Messiah would be God's Holy One.

Approximately one thousand years after that was said in **Psalm 16:10**, the Apostle Peter took the Scriptures and was speaking from that very portion as recorded in **Acts 2**, he said -

**27 Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.**

**28 Thou hast made known to me the ways of life; thou shalt make me full of joy with thy countenance.**

**29 Men and brethren, let me freely speak unto you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his sepulcher is with us unto this day.**

**30 Therefore being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, he raised up Christ to sit on his - God's - throne;**

**31 He, seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither did his flesh see corruption.**

**32**            **This Jesus. . . -this lovely Lord Jesus -. . . hath God raised up, whereof of we all are witnesses.**

**33**            **Therefore being at the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.**

**34**            **For David is not ascended into the heavens: but he saith himself, The Lord said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand,**

**35**            **Until I make thy foes thy footstool.** (That quotation is from \_ Psalm 110: 1).

Let me explain what was going on. It was a declared, known fact with the early disciples that the Lord Jesus was holy. It was understood that through that line, that seed recorded from **Genesis**, conceived within the virgin by the Holy One, was holy - the Lord Jesus. This One would sit upon the holy throne of God. He would be the greater David. King David, as has been described in these Scriptures, had already died and his bones were in some sepulcher nearby, but not the bones of Jesus for He had risen from the dead and had ascended on high. And, as the Holy Son of God, perfectly holy, He alone intercedes for you and me. Can you understand that when you feel so condemned by the accusations of the devil; can you understand when you feel so suicidal and so hopeless and you think there is no answer for tomorrow because all

these pressures come around, it is the Lord Jesus Christ who said, "I am holy on your behalf?" I became sin in my spotless, sinless body for you that I might stand before a holy God for you!"

Therefore, today I want you to turn all that enormous black cloud of despair and hopelessness of your life to Him and say, *Jesus, right now You are standing for me with all I am carrying. I thank You. You are sinless and spotless and You are willing, as My Savior, my Lord, today to deliver me.*
